

# Information sheet on CC licences and publishing open educational resources (OER) at the ZHAW

#### 1. Introduction

In its <u>Open Educational Resources (OER) Policy</u>, the ZHAW recommends the use of openly licensed teaching materials in order to make the most of didactic synergies, content sharing and gain new perspectives. The OER Policy also encourages active participation in the culture of sharing by publishing your own teaching materials as OER.

This information sheet provides instructions on the use of Creative Commons licences (CC licences) and standardised text templates for the publication of OER. It contains information on the use of the ZHAW logo and corporate design as well as about the required approvals, the handling of cited works in OER and the combination of works under different CC licences.

## 2. Scope

The content of this information sheet applies to all employees, lecturers, research associates and students who use or publish teaching materials at the ZHAW under open licences.

## 3. Publication of ZHAW teaching materials under a CC licence

By granting a CC licence, you allow others to use and re-publish your work. With the <u>CC BY</u> and <u>CC BY-SA</u> licences, you also consent to your work being adapted and used for commercial purposes. This is on the condition that the author is named.



Overview of CC licences and their requirements



For publication under a CC licence, include the icon and the link to the licence in your work. It is not necessary to register with or upload the work to Creative Commons.

# 3.1 Decision for a licence

The ZHAW <u>Open Educational Resources (OER) Policy</u> recommends licensing alternatively under:

Icon	Designation	Description
	CC BY (copyright attribution)	May be re-published, adapted and used commercially.
CC O O BY SA	<u>CC BY-SA</u> (copyright attribution and publication under the same "share alike" conditions)	May be re-published, adapted and used commercially when made available under the same licence.

If you would like to specify further restrictions (not commercial, no adaptation), use the <u>CC licence chooser</u> to determine your licence.



CC icons to download



Wherever possible, include the licence designation directly in your work. If this isn't possible, the reference should be made as close to the work as possible.

## 3.2 Indicating the licence in your work

At the end of your work, include the following:

- The licence icon with a link to the licence text
- The licence designation with a link to the licence text or URL
- Your name(s)
- Your institution(s)
- Current status of the work

# 3.3 Required approvals upon publishing under a CC licence

#### 3.3.1 Line managers at the ZHAW

Under the <u>law governing the Zurich universities of applied sciences and arts</u> (FaHG § 16(1)(b)), the rights of use for copyright-protected works that have been created by university staff in performing their official duties lie with the university. While the rights of use remain with the ZHAW upon publishing such a work under a CC licence and indicating the institution in accordance with section 2, a corresponding request or permission from your line manager is still required. For reasons of proof, you should give preference to the provision of written confirmation (e.g. e-mail).

#### 3.3.2 Depicted persons

Where not necessary, avoid depicting recognisable individuals in openly licensed works.

Works that are published under a CC licence may be used and re-published by third parties without any limitations as regards the purpose of the use. (Only commercial use can be excluded through the NC licence element.) Once a CC licence has been issued, it cannot be revoked.

The choice of a licence with the element ND (no derivatives) can, if necessary, prevent individuals being depicted in unwanted contexts.

Always obtain written consent from all individuals who can be recognised in the work (e.g. via their face or voice).



Form: Consent from individuals for publication under a CC licence

Make reference to the consent in your work to ensure legal certainty for third parties who want to re-use the work:

# 3.4 Using the ZHAW trademark and corporate design

#### 3.4.1 ZHAW logo and trademark

The use of the ZHAW logo in materials under a CC licence is permitted. Wherever possible, however, include a disclaimer:

#### 3.4.2 ZHAW templates, intro/outro for videos

The Microsoft Office templates in the ZHAW layout<sup>3</sup> and the ZHAW video intro and outro<sup>4</sup> (as of May 2021) can be used under a CC licence. This does not infringe on third-party rights.

When using intros/outros or other media elements of the Schools, please make sure that their publication under a CC licence is permitted.

#### 4. Use of third-party materials



Only use materials that are under open licences, for example under a CC licence. Resources from the Internet that are not marked with a licence are copyright-protected and may only be used with the consent of the author.<sup>5</sup>

#### 4.1 Attribution of CC-licensed materials according to the TULLU rule

To comply with the licensing requirements of CC BY licences, identify the materials according to the TULLU rule (referred to as TALLO in English).

Include the:

- Title
- Author
- Licence

Where possible, also label public domain / CC0 works so that you can prove the origin of the material in case of doubt.

If you publish your own work under a CC licence, exclude third-party works from this licence using a disclaimer.

#### 4.2 Identification of works for which you have the consent of the author

Where necessary, obtain consent from the author if you would like to use images, videos, screenshots, audio files, logos, etc. from the Internet that are not under an open licence. When doing so, go into as much detail as possible about the planned use and licensing of your material. Written consent (e.g. via e-mail) is essential for reasons of proof. Indicate that you

#### 4.4 *Citing* images and audio material

The right of quotation requires that the content of the relevant image, audio or text material be dealt with in depth (<u>CopA</u> Art. 25). Images, videos and audio recordings that are used for the purpose of illustration or that in used to replace your own material do not meet this criterion.

- In terms of scope, you may use no more third-party material than is required to support your own statements.
- As is the case when citing texts, name the original source of the cited work.



If you publish your own work under a CC licence, exclude cited sources from this licence using a disclaimer:

#### 4.5 Combining materials that are under different CC licences



The CC-licensed materials that you are allowed to use in your work depend on the type of compilation.<sup>6</sup>
